

**NASCAR® Swear Jar Promotion
Official Rules**

- **NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE OF ANY KIND DOES NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.**
- **VOID WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW.**
- **ALL DISPUTES WILL BE RESOLVED SOLELY BY BINDING ARBITRATION AND ENTRANTS WAIVE THE ABILITY TO BRING CLAIMS IN A CLASS ACTION FORMAT.**

BY ENTERING (OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATING IN) THE PROMOTION, YOU AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, WHICH ARE A BINDING CONTRACT, SO READ THEM CAREFULLY BEFORE ENTERING. WITHOUT LIMITATION, THIS CONTRACT INCLUDES INDEMNITIES TO THE RELEASED PARTIES FROM YOU AND A LIMITATION OF YOUR RIGHTS AND REMEDIES.

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** The NASCAR Swear Jar Promotion ("Promotion") is open only to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and the District of Columbia, who are eighteen (18) years of age or older as of date of entry. Employees, officers and directors of 72andSunny Partners LLC ("Sponsor"), Realtime Media LLC ("Administrator"), NASCAR, LLC, and their respective parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, grantors, lessees, owners, lessors, and each of their respective shareholders, directors, officers, members, successors, agents and advertising, contest, fulfillment and marketing agencies (collectively, the "Released Parties"), their immediate family members and those living in the same household as such individuals (whether legally related or not) are not eligible to participate in the Promotion or win the prize. For purposes of this Promotion, immediate family members are defined as spouse, partner, parents, legal guardians, in-laws, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren and their respective spouses, and those living in the same household shall mean people who share the same residence at least three (3) months a year, whether legally related or not. Void where prohibited by law. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply. By participating in the Promotion, you unconditionally accept and agree to comply with and abide by these "Official Rules" and the decisions of Sponsor, including the interpretation of these Official Rules, administration of the Promotion, determination of the finalists and winner, and Sponsor's exercise of discretion, which will be final, non-appealable, and binding in all respects.
2. **PROMOTION OVERVIEW:** The Promotion is a prediction-based game of chance with a prize pool of variable value determined by an external trigger. During each of the nine (9) Entry Periods (as defined below), participants will have the opportunity to submit the number of Swear Words (as defined below) expected during the upcoming NASCAR Cup Series® race broadcast associated with that Entry Period (each, a "Race") as well as a prediction of the most-used Swear Word during such Race (collectively, the "Prediction"). Eligible swear words (each a "Swear Word") are listed at the Website and are determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. At the end of each Entry Period, one (1) "Finalist" will be determined by comparing the entrant's Prediction against Sponsor's count of the total number of Swear Words and most frequently used Swear Word recorded for the associated Race. At the end of the Entry Periods, the nine (9) Finalists must submit a final Prediction for a 10th Race, and the one (1) winner will be determined by comparing the Finalist's submitted Prediction against Sponsor's count of the total number of Swear Words and most frequently used Swear Word recorded during the 10th Race. The prize pool value will increase over the Promotion Period as funds are placed into a "swear jar".
3. **TIMING:** The Promotion begins at or about 1:00 p.m. (noon) Eastern Time ("ET") on September 4, 2026 and ends at 11:59 a.m. ET on November 1, 2026 (the "Promotion Period"). The Promotion Period is comprised of nine (9) entry periods (each, an "Entry Period") as set forth below:

Guesses submitted in an Entry Period **DO NOT** carry forward. To participate in an Entry Period you must submit a guess during that Entry Period.

The nine (9) Finalists must submit their Predictions in a "Finalist Period" between 12:00 p.m. ET on November 2, 2026 and 11:59 a.m. ET on November 8, 2026 for the Race scheduled for November 8, 2026 to be eligible to win the prize. Only the Finalists will be able to participate in the Finalist Period.

The designated computer clock of Administrator is the official time-keeping device in the Promotion.

4. **HOW TO ENTER:** During the Promotion Period, visit <https://nascarswearjar.com> ("Website") and complete and submit the registration form, including your full name, complete address (no P.O. Boxes), email address, and date of birth. Upon completion of the registration form you will be assigned an "Alias Name" that will be displayed on the Promotion "Leaderboard" if you are the Finalist for the Entry Period. Then, follow the on-screen instructions to submit your Prediction including your estimate of the total number of Swear Words expected during the entire audio feed from NASCAR for the associated Race as well as what you think the most said Swear Word will be from the drop-down menu. The audio feed is expected to start approximately 30 minutes prior to the start of the Race and ends when the live broadcast and team communications conclude. In subsequent Entry Periods you may return to the Website, log in with your email address, and submit your Prediction. Once a Prediction is submitted, it cannot be changed.

The Released Parties are not responsible for technical difficulties of any kind, including, but not limited to, any failure, inaccessibility, or interruption of the NASCAR audio feed; or for false, incorrect, changed, incomplete or illegible contact information. Further, the Released Parties and Race event organizers are not responsible or liable for any delay, postponement, cancellation, or alteration of a Race caused by inclement weather, acts of God, unforeseeable events, or any other safety concerns or other forces beyond their reasonable control.

LIMIT: One (1) registration per person during the entire Promotion Period and one (1) Prediction per person per Entry Period. Attempts made by the same individual to register more than once or to submit more than the stated number of Predictions by using multiple or false contact information, accounts or otherwise may result in disqualification. Registrations or Predictions generated by artificial intelligence, script, computer programs, macro, programmed, robotic or other automated means are void and may be disqualified. Registrations or Predictions that are in excess of the stated limit(s), incomplete, illegible, corrupted, damaged, destroyed, forged, false, lost, late or misdirected, deceptive or otherwise not in compliance with the Official Rules may be disqualified from the Promotion at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. Those who do not provide the required information on their registration form, follow all directions, or abide by these Official Rules or other instructions of Sponsor may be disqualified. Registrations or Predictions submitted by those who do not meet the eligibility requirements (including all requirements with respect to age and residence) are void. In the event of a dispute over the identity of an entrant, registration will be deemed submitted by the registered account holder of the email address associated with such registration (and its associated Predictions), provided that person is eligible. Any potential Finalist and/or winner may be required to show proof of being the registered account holder. Registered account holder is defined as the person assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning email addresses. In the event that a dispute regarding the identity of the individual who submitted an entry cannot be resolved to Sponsor's satisfaction, the affected entry will be deemed ineligible.

- 5. FINALIST DETERMINATION:** After the Race broadcast is completed, Sponsor will compile and tally the total number of Swear Words heard during the Race based on the audio transcript. The tally will include all Swear Words heard from every team member in the full field, including, but not limited to, drivers, crew chiefs, spotters, and other team personnel captured on the audio feed. Sponsor's count and tally determination will be made in its sole and absolute discretion and is non-appealable.

Each entrant will receive a score for their Prediction based on the following points structure:

- 5 points for the correct Swear Word predicted to be used most frequently
- 10 points for predicting the exact total Swear Word count
- If a Prediction was not the exact total Swear Word count, but within a 5 word count of the exact total (plus or minus), 5 points will be awarded

The one (1) entrant with the highest number of points for the Entry Period will be named the Finalist, subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules. In the event of a tie, the Finalist will be determined as the entrant who submitted their Prediction first, according to the Administrator's time stamp. The Finalist's Alias Name will be published to the leaderboard on the Monday after the Race once points have been assigned.

If any Finalist is found to be ineligible or if the Finalist does not comply with these Official Rules, the Finalist will be disqualified, and the entrant with the next highest number of points will be named the Finalist. Sponsor's decisions shall be final and binding in all matters pertaining to the determination of the Finalists. If the Prediction with the highest number of points for an Entry Period was made by an entrant already named as a Finalist, then the entrant with the next-highest number of points will be named that Entry Period's Finalist. An entrant may only be named a Finalist once during the Promotion Period, regardless of performance in subsequent Entry Periods.

No more than one (1) Finalist per Entry Period will be named.

- 6. WINNER DETERMINATION:** Finalists are responsible for checking the leaderboard to note their Finalist standing, as well as responding to any notification from the Sponsor or Administrator in case additional verification is required. During the Finalist Period, each Finalist must log in to the Website and submit their Prediction for the Race scheduled for November 8, 2026. If a Finalist fails to submit a Prediction by 11:59 a.m. ET on November 8, 2026, such Finalist will not be eligible to win the prize.

At the conclusion of the Race, Sponsor will review the transcript using the same process set forth above and assign points using the same rubric as above. The one (1) Finalist with the most points, as determined by Sponsor, will be named the potential winner. In the event of a tie, the one (1) winner will be determined in a random drawing from among all tied Finalists.

The winner is subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules, as set forth below. All of Sponsor's decisions shall be final and binding in the determination of the winner. No more than one (1) winner will be named.

- 7. ODDS:** Odds of being determined as a Finalist or winning the prize depend on the independent variables of the number and match of Swear Words recorded by Sponsor during a Race and the time stamp of an entrant's Prediction.
- 8. WINNER NOTIFICATION/PRIZE CLAIMING:** The potential winner will be notified via email (or other contact information) using the information provided on the registration form in a commercially reasonable time after the November 8, 2026 Race. The Released Parties are not responsible for and shall not be liable for incorrect, changed, or illegible contact information or for electronic communications that are undeliverable as a result of any form of active or passive filtering, or insufficient space in entrant's email or other account to receive messages. Released Parties are not responsible for late, lost, intercepted, misdirected, or unsuccessful efforts to notify the potential winner. Notification

is deemed to have occurred immediately upon the sending of an email. As part of the winner notification process, the potential winner will be required to complete and submit a declaration of eligibility/release of liability/prize acceptance agreement ("Declaration"), within three (3) days of date of notification, as a condition of receiving the prize. If any notification (including the Declaration) is returned as rejected, faulty, unclaimed or returned as undeliverable to the potential winner; or if the potential winner cannot be contacted within a reasonable time period, fails or refuses to sign and return the Declaration within the required time period, and/or the potential winner is ineligible or otherwise fails to fully comply with these Official Rules; the potential winner will be disqualified. In the event the potential winner is disqualified, the Finalist with the next-highest number of points awarded in the Finalist Period will be named the potential winner, subject to the verification process set forth above. This process will continue until a winner is confirmed, or Finalists are exhausted, at which point the prize will remain un-awarded. The potential winner becomes the "winner" only after verification of eligibility by Sponsor.

In the event the winner is a resident of Alabama or Nebraska and under the age of nineteen (19), a parent or legal guardian may be required to also sign the Declaration in order for the winner to be qualified to receive the prize.

No more than one (1) prize will be awarded. If, for any reason, more bona fide winners come forward seeking to claim the prize, the winner may be selected in a random drawing from among all persons making purportedly valid claims. Inclusion in such drawing shall be each entrant's sole and exclusive remedy under such circumstances.

9. PRIZE/PRIZE RESTRICTIONS: The prize to be awarded in this Promotion is:

One (1) Prize: The winner will receive the total value of the swear jar awarded as a check made payable to the winner. The total value of the swear jar is a progressive prize pool value and will be determined by Sponsor based on depositing at least \$1 to up to \$15 per Swear Word.

Sponsor reserves the right to adjust the value per Swear Word in its sole discretion for a specific Race. If such an adjustment is made, notice may be posted to the Website and/or on Sponsor's or NASCAR's social media. In no event will a value per Swear Word be less than \$1.

The value will be calculated cumulatively over the course of the 10 Races. The maximum approximate retail value ("ARV") of the prize is \$15,000.

Prize is non-transferable, with no substitutions except at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. All prize details not specified in these Official Rules will be determined in Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion. Prize details and availability are subject to change and are subject to applicable rules and restrictions. The winner will be solely responsible for all federal, state and/or local taxes, and for any other fees or costs associated with the prize received, regardless of whether it, in whole or in part, is used. If the value of the prize is \$2,000 or more, the value of the prize will be reported for tax purposes as required by law. In that circumstance, the winner will be required to provide Sponsor with a valid social security number before the prize will be awarded for tax reporting purposes. An IRS Form 1099 will be issued in the name of the winner for the actual value of the prize received, if the prize is valued at \$2,000 or more. Any unclaimed prize will be forfeited. Prize, if legitimately claimed, will be awarded. The Released Parties are not responsible for and will not replace any lost, mutilated, or stolen prize or any prize that is undeliverable or does not reach the winner because of an incorrect or changed address. Sponsor will attempt to fulfill the properly-claimed prize within approximately four (4) to six (6) weeks after winner verification.

10. GENERAL: Subject to applicable law, each Finalist hereby expressly grants to the Released Parties and their respective successors, assigns, sublicensees and designees, the irrevocable right to use and publish Finalist's name, Alias Name, social handles, likeness (photographic or simulated), voice, biography and place of residence for all purposes, including, without limitation, advertising, marketing, promotional and publicity purposes in connection with this Promotion ("Advertising"), in any and all media now or hereafter devised, worldwide, in perpetuity, without any form of notice, permission or any

amount or kind of compensation, except for the awarding of the prize to the winner. All copyright, trademark or other intellectual property rights in such Advertising shall be owned by Sponsor and/or its licensors, and each Finalist hereby disclaims and waives any claim of right to such Advertising. Such Advertising shall be solely under the control of Sponsor and/or its licensors, and each Finalist hereby waives any claim of control over the Advertising content as well as any possible claims of misuse of winner's name, likeness or voice under contract, tort or any other theory of law. The Released Parties do not assume any responsibility for any disruption in the Promotion, including, but not limited to, the failure or interruption of any social media platform or any internet service provider. In the event there is a discrepancy or inconsistency between disclosures and other statements contained in any Promotion materials and the terms and conditions of these Official Rules, these Official Rules shall prevail, govern, and control. In the event Sponsor is prevented from continuing with the Promotion by any event beyond its control, including, but not limited to, fire, flood, epidemic, earthquake, explosion, labor dispute or strike, act of God or public enemy, communications or equipment failure, utility or service interruptions, riot or civil disturbance, terrorist threat or activity, war (declared or undeclared), interference with the Promotion by any party, or any federal, state, or local government law, order, or regulation, order of any court or jurisdiction, or other cause not reasonably within Sponsor's control (each, a "Force Majeure" event or occurrence), Sponsor shall have the right to modify, suspend or terminate the Promotion or prize. Sponsor additionally reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion to modify, suspend or terminate the Promotion should causes beyond Sponsor's control corrupt or interfere with the administration, integrity, operation, security or proper play of the Promotion.

11. CONDUCT: The Released Parties are not responsible for the actions of entrants in connection with the Promotion, including entrants' attempts to circumvent the Official Rules or otherwise interfere with the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the Promotion. The Released Parties reserve the right, at their sole discretion, to disqualify (or terminate the prize of) any individual who is found to be, or suspected of, acting in any manner deemed by the Released Parties to be in violation of the Official Rules, or to be unsportsmanlike or disruptive, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person, or to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Promotion, and void all associated entries and/or registrations. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT BY A USER, YOU OR ANY OTHER INDIVIDUAL TO DAMAGE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE PROMOTION IS A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS, AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE RELEASED PARTIES RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) FROM ANY SUCH PERSON TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

12. WAIVERS AND DISCLAIMERS: The Released Parties assume no responsibility or liability for: (a) lost, late, stolen, undelivered, inaccurate, incomplete, delayed, misdirected, damaged or garbled registrations, entries, URLs, or emails; (b) any incorrect or inaccurate entry information, or for any faulty or failed electronic data transmissions; (c) any unauthorized access to, or theft, destruction or alteration of entries or registrations at any point in the operation of this Promotion; (d) any technical malfunction, failure, error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation or communications line failure, regardless of cause, with regard to any equipment, systems, networks, lines, cable, satellites, servers, computers or providers utilized in any aspect of the operation of the Promotion; (e) inaccessibility or unavailability of the Internet or the website or any combination thereof or for computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties, or other errors or difficulties of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, computer, network, typographical, printing or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Promotion, including, without limitation, errors or difficulties which may occur in connection with the administration of the Promotion, the processing of entries, social networking posts, or registrations, the announcement of the prizes, or in any other Promotion-related materials; or (f) any injury or damage to entrants or to any other person's computer which may be related to or resulting from any attempt to participate in the Promotion. If, for any reason, the Promotion (or any part thereof) is not capable of running as planned for reasons which may include, without limitation, infection by computer virus, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or any other causes which may corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Promotion, then the Released Parties reserve the right at their sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Promotion in whole or in part.

13. RELEASES: All entrants, as a condition of participation in this Promotion, release, discharge, indemnify and hold harmless the Released Parties, and each of their respective shareholders, directors, officers, employees, members, agents, successors and assigns (collectively, "Released Parties") from and against any and all liability, claims, costs (including attorneys' fees), losses, damages, fines, or actions of any kind whatsoever for injuries, death, damages, or losses to persons or property which may be sustained, in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, in connection with: (i) participation in any aspect of the Promotion (including travel to/from any Promotion activity), (ii) the receipt, ownership, use or misuse of the prize awarded, including any travel associated with any prize, (iii) the Released Parties' violation of rights of publicity or privacy, claims of defamation or portrayal in a false light or based on any claim of infringement of intellectual property; (iv) entrant's registration material on any related website, or (v) any typographical, human or other error in the printing, offering, selection, operation or announcement of any Promotion activity and/or prize. Winner assumes all liability for any injury or damage caused or claimed to be caused by participation in this Promotion or use or redemption of any prize.

14. GOVERNING LAW AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY: All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of these Official Rules or the rights and obligations of entrants, Sponsor or the Released Parties in connection with the Promotion will be governed by and construed in accordance with the internal laws of the State of California, without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other laws.

BY ENTERING THE PROMOTION, ENTRANT AGREES THAT TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW: (A) ANY AND ALL DISPUTES, CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION ARISING OUT OF OR CONNECTED WITH THE PROMOTION, OR ANY PRIZE AWARDED, WILL BE RESOLVED INDIVIDUALLY, WITHOUT RESORT TO ANY FORM OF CLASS ACTION; (B) ANY AND ALL CLAIMS, JUDGMENTS AND AWARDS WILL BE LIMITED TO ACTUAL THIRD-PARTY, OUT-OF-POCKET COSTS INCURRED (IF ANY) NOT TO EXCEED TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), BUT IN NO EVENT WILL ATTORNEYS' FEES BE AWARDED OR RECOVERABLE; (C) UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES WILL ANY ENTRANT BE PERMITTED TO OBTAIN ANY AWARD FOR, AND ENTRANT HEREBY KNOWINGLY AND EXPRESSLY WAIVES ALL RIGHTS TO SEEK, PUNITIVE, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL OR SPECIAL DAMAGES, LOST PROFITS AND/OR ANY OTHER DAMAGES, OTHER THAN ACTUAL OUT OF POCKET EXPENSES NOT TO EXCEED TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00), AND/OR ANY RIGHTS TO HAVE DAMAGES MULTIPLIED OR OTHERWISE INCREASED; AND (D) ENTRANTS' REMEDIES ARE LIMITED TO A CLAIM FOR MONEY DAMAGES (IF ANY) AND ENTRANT IRREVOCABLY WAIVES ANY RIGHT TO SEEK INJUNCTIVE OR EQUITABLE RELIEF. SOME JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE LIMITATIONS OR EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY, SO THE ABOVE MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

15. DISPUTE RESOLUTION: The parties each agree to finally settle all disputes only through arbitration; provided, however, the Sponsor shall be entitled to seek injunctive or equitable relief in the state and federal courts in the State of California, and any other court with jurisdiction over the parties. In arbitration, there is no judge or jury, and review is limited. The arbitrator's decision and award is final and binding, with limited exceptions, and judgment on the award may be entered in any court with jurisdiction. The parties agree that, except as set forth above, any claim, suit, action or proceeding arising out of or relating to this Promotion shall be resolved solely by binding arbitration before a sole arbitrator under the streamlined Arbitration Rules Procedures of JAMS Inc. ("JAMS") or any successor to JAMS. In the event JAMS is unwilling or unable to set a hearing date within fourteen (14) days of the filing of a "Demand for Arbitration", then either party can elect to have the arbitration administered by the American Arbitration Association ("AAA") or any other mutually agreeable arbitration administration service. If an in-person hearing is required, then it will take place in the State of California. The federal or state law that applies to these Official Rules will also apply during the arbitration. Disputes will be arbitrated only on an individual basis and will not be consolidated with any other proceedings that involve any claims or controversy of another party, including any class actions; provided, however, if for any reason any court or arbitrator holds that this restriction is unconscionable or unenforceable, then the agreement to arbitrate doesn't apply and the dispute must be brought in a court of competent

jurisdiction in the State of California. Sponsor agrees to pay the administrative and arbitrator's fees in order to conduct the arbitration (but specifically excluding any travel or other costs of entrant to attend the arbitration hearing). Either party may, notwithstanding this provision, bring qualifying claims in small claims court.

- 16. ENTRY INFORMATION AND PROMOTION COMMUNICATIONS:** As a condition of participating in the Promotion, each entrant gives consent for Sponsor to obtain and deliver his or her name, address and other information to third parties for the purpose of administering this Promotion and to comply with applicable laws, regulations and rules. Any information an entrant provides to the Sponsor may be used to communicate with the entrant in relation to this Promotion or on a Promotion winner's list. By participating in the Promotion, each entrant agrees to all of the terms and conditions of NASCAR's Privacy Policy, which is available at <https://www.nascar.com/ndmnetworkprivacystatement/>. In the event of any discrepancy between the NASCAR's Privacy Policy and these Official Rules, these Official Rules shall control and govern.
- 17. MISCELLANEOUS:** The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of these Official Rules will not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision. In the event that any provision of the Official Rules is determined to be invalid or otherwise unenforceable or illegal, the other provisions will remain in effect and will be construed in accordance with their terms as if the invalid or illegal provision were not contained herein. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules will not constitute a waiver of that provision. Entrants agree to waive any rights to claim ambiguity of these Official Rules. Headings are solely for convenience of reference and will not be deemed to affect in any manner the meaning or intent of the documents or any provision hereof.
